Unfortunately, Harvest Garden has been closed temporarily as a result of the Coronavirus and we are unable to assist Call Primrose, a non-profit organization providing grocery assistance to low income families in San Mateo County, with the much needed and appreciated fresh produce as we have in prior years. As soon as the shelter in place order is lifted, we will follow the guidelines the state requires and start planting for Summer and Fall so we can once again support Call Primrose. Under ordinary circumstances, HBF donates over 1000 pounds of produce from Harvest Garden to Call Primrose each year.
