Hillsborough Beautification Foundation reimagined our typical year to continue to positively impact our lovely town during this past year. As you peruse the photographs and updates in this newsletter, we hope you agree that we have succeeded.

As an organization, we embraced our mission of "Enhancing the beauty of our public landscape, encouraging community engagement and civic pride" with creativity and enthusiasm, seeking to bring our community together in new and meaningful ways. Our **virtual Veterans Day Celebration** was viewed by more than 700 people and included an in-depth interview with resident and World War II veteran, Edward Medzian. We transformed **Light Up The Town** into a joyful drive-thru celebration. Harvest Garden Growing Strong



HBF's Harvest Garden provided a wonderful way for a small team of interns, community members and a committed team of Master Gardeners to spend last summer during the pandemic. While long-time recipient of our harvest, CALL Primrose, was unable to accept our

donations this past year, we were able to connect with a **new organization, GROW San Mateo,** and redirected our harvest to **Samaritan House's Food Pharmacy** program. GROW San Mateo (www.growsanmateo.org), a small, but highly effective non-profit, has been actively collecting produce from community gardens throughout the immediate area for over a year and partnering with the Samaritan House Food Pharmacy **to address food insecurity in the local underserved community**.

HBF is thrilled to be in partnership with GROW San Mateo and we've been able to learn more about food needs in our community and adjust our Harvest Garden growing patterns accordingly. Moving into spring and summer, we are planning our planting around what the clients at the Food Pharmacy are most inclined to eat. This includes peppers, tomatoes, cucumbers, chayote, potatoes and a variety of herbs. As part of our goal to feed those most impacted by the COVID19 pandemic, **HBF/Harvest Garden has also partnered with Hillsborough Helping** to collect fresh home-grown produce at the local donation stations in Town. If you have a bounty of fruits on your trees, please consider donating your excess at the collection sites on Tuesdays 9am-1pm. Please donate only home-grown, not overripe produce.
